

# Who is EUROCONTROLINATION OF THE PARKET OF T



ICAO: The contracting States recognise that every State has complete and exclusive sovereignty over the airspace above its territory.



#### EUROCONTROL

- 41 Member States, typically each with its own ANSP
- Approximately 64 Area Control Centres (ACC)
- Over 700 sectors when at full capacity
- Approx. 17,000 Air Traffic Controllers
- 14.2 million flight hours controlled







- First single industry sector global market-based measure in the field of climate action
- Forecast to mitigate around 2.5 billion tonnes of CO2 between 2021 and 2035
- Started on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 (baseline period)
- Objective: carbon neutral growth from 2020
- Emissions above 2020 levels will be offset through the acquisition and redemption of emissions units reduction generated outside of the international aviation sector



## A phased approach





- Participation of States in the pilot phase (2021 to 2023) and first phase (2024 to 2026) is voluntary.
- For the second phase from 2027, all States with an individual share of international aviation activity in year 2018 above 0.5% of total activity or whose cumulative share reaches 90% of total activity, are included. Least Developed Countries, Small Island Developing States and Landlocked Developing Countries are exempt unless they volunteer to participate.



As of 1st January 2024, 126 States intend to voluntarily participate in CORSIA from its outset.



# A route-based approaches

#### Fuel consumed on ALL international civil aviation flights must be monitored



- A route will be covered by the scheme if both States connecting the route are participating in the scheme;
- A route will not be covered by the scheme if one or both of States connecting the route are not participating in the scheme

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## **CORSIA CERT**



- The CORSIA CO2 Estimation and Reporting Tool the CERT is a tool to estimate flight by flight CO<sub>2</sub> emissions based on actual flight data provided by operators.
- All operators can use it to use it to assess CO<sub>2</sub> for their flights
- Operators with less than 50,000 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions on flights subject to offsetting can use it to report





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

### Data Exchange between States

Individual bilateral agreements



Each State collects all traffic through bilateral data exchange agreements with the States in which all the AOs it manages operate.

The State then processes all the data and executes a decoupling mechanism to consolidate traffic for each AO, filtering out duplicates and corrupted information.




## Central Data Exchange

## Data Exchange in Practice



#### Flight Data Exchange between States

Collegial approach emulating a multilateral agreement

- Each State signs a single bilateral agreement with EUROCONTROL
  - Committing to provide data in a single common "container" managed by EUROCONTROL
  - Agreeing this data to be made available to other such states on a "need to know for CORSIA" basis
  - Entitling it to have access to data of other providing states on a "need to know for CORSIA" basis
  - EUROCONTROL engages on the same basis for the data it holds for its Member States
- Economies of scale in data processing
- Data exchange is free of charge for EUROCONTROL and the State, each covers its own costs
- In force with Singapore CAA
